Dear Professor Morimoto,

I would like to thank you for the valuable contribution made by your institution during the past years of designation as a WHO collaborating centre. I am pleased to inform you that the World Health Organization has redesignated the University of Occupational and Environmental Health, Japan, Institute of Industrial Ecological Sciences, as a WHO Collaborating Centre for Occupational Health, under WHO's reference number JPN-53.

As previously agreed, you will act as the Head for the work under this collaborating centre. Should there be any change in the future, I would be grateful if you would inform WHO without delay.

The designation of the University of Occupational and Environmental Health, Japan, Institute of Industrial Ecological Sciences, as a WHO collaborating centre will be effective for a period of four years, as from 23 July 2020, and will automatically end on 23 July 2024, unless redesignation has been approved by WHO before that date. During the period of designation, either party may revoke the designation at any time by giving three months advance notice in writing.
