From February 17 to 20, UOEH organized a group training program on occupational health in Japan for 28 participants, including medical doctors, public health nurses, and graduate students, from three Thai partner institutions with which we have concluded academic exchange agreements: the Department of Disease Control of the Ministry of Public Health, the Faculty of Public Health at Thammasat University, and the Faculty of Public Health at Mahidol University. In addition to lectures on the history and system of Japanese occupational health, we conducted tours of our campus facilities. We also visited the Nishinohon Occupational Health Service Center and the Yaskawa Electric Corporation Nakama Plant which provided a valuable opportunity to observe occupational health practices in Japan. This training program significantly enhanced participants' understanding of occupational health while offering a valuable platform for networking and future collaborations.
