<International Nursing Special Program: UOEH hosted the delegation from Department of Nursing, Wonkwang University, Korea>

From August 19 to 22, the Department of Nursing, School of Health Sciences, UOEH hosted a total of 11 participants including 3 faculty members and 8 second-year undergraduate students from the Department of Nursing, Wonkwang University, Iksan, South Korea under the International Nursing Special Program.

The International Nursing Special Program is an annual program in which nursing students are mutually dispatched to each university every other year for a training program. UOEH students have visited Wonkwang University last year and this was the first time for UOEH to host the delegation. A total of 20 students including 7 second-year and 13 first-year nursing students participated from UOEH. Following the welcome reception, the delegation visited the nursing practice rooms, research facilities, and the university hospital at UOEH, and both students gave presentations in English (introduction of the nursing system and student life, etc.). They also visited the Shabondama Soap Co., Ltd. in Wakamatsu as well as Kokura Castle and other places in the city center. At the farewell reception, certificate of completion was handed to all the participants. Although it was a short period of time, the intensive schedule contributed to deepen the friendship between the Japanese and Korean students, cultivated their global perspectives, and promoted cross-cultural understanding, making it a meaningful international exchange.
