On August 22-23, the yearly academic conference was hosted by Nopparat Rajathanee Hospital, Department of Medical Services, Ministry of Public Health, Thailand at Petch Nopparat Conference Hall in Bangkok, Thailand. On Thursday, August 22, and Prof. Yasuo Morimoto (Dept. of Occupational Pneumology) gave a lecture on “Current Status of air pollution in the Asia Pacific region and efforts to improve air quality in Japan”. The theme of this conference was air pollution and its impact on the world. The participants discussed air pollution in Thailand and how to deal with its health effects, etc. A total of 500 people including 200 doctors, nurses and other professionals in the hall, and 300 at the satellite venue attended.

There was a lively discussion on how to deal with high-risk groups for air pollution such as the elderly and children, transboundary air pollution and environmental pollution outpatient programs in Thailand.
