Prof. Yasuo Morimoto (Dept. of Occupational Pneumology) and Assoc. Prof. Tomohiro Ishimaru (Dept. of Medical Humanities) together with members of Catholic University of Korea and National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health, Japan (online participation only) delivered lectures at the “Occupational Lung Disease: Asbestos Related Diseases” International Conference in Mongolia on July 1.

This conference was hosted by the Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences and supported by WHO Western Pacific Regional Office, Mongolian Respiratory Society and The First Central Hospital of Mongolia, and UOEH as a WHO Collaborating Centers in Occupational Health supported the event by providing lectures on the theme.

Approximately 30 pulmonologists took part in this conference aimed at providing education in the Occupational Lung Diseases especially on Asbestos Related Diseases. In the first half, Prof. Morimoto talked about pathophysiology aspect of Asbestos Related Diseases as well as the system for occupational injury compensation and special health examination in Japan and explained about the situation of Asbestos use in Mongolia. In the latter half, to cover wide range of topics, Prof. Morimoto talked about measures against air pollution, Assoc. Ishimaru introduced epidemiology studies and other members provided information on working environment measurement and improvement of workplace environment in Korea and Japan.
