<Lectures at training program on Mesothelioma and Asbestos-Related Disease>

Prof. Yasuo Morimoto (Dept. of Occupational Pneumology) provided two recorded lectures entitled “History of asbestos use and asbestos-related diseases in Japan” and “History of asbestos use and asbestos-related diseases in Japan.” at the training program on Mesothelioma and Asbestos-Related Disease which were held in Lao PDR and Vietnam during May 8-10 and 13-15 respectively.

This training program was organized by the Asbestos and Dust Diseases Research Institute, Australia (ADDRI) with which we have concluded MOU for academic collaboration. It is also a collaboration as WHO Collaborating Centers (WHOCC) as both ADDRI and Institute of Industrial Ecological Sciences, UOEH are WHOCC for Occupational Health.

A total of 50 physicians from Vietnam and approximately 70 from Lao PDR participated in the training program, including pathology, radiology, oncology, and patient care professionals.
