<International Center hosted UOEH International Symposium 2024>


International Center hosted UOEH International Symposium 2024 at Ramazzini Hall of the UOEH campus and online on November 8 and 9. The symposium's theme was "AI in Human Factors and Ergonomics -how should we apply the disruptive technologies to occupational health?", and total of 10 speakers from 8 countries (Brazil, Colombia, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand) provided excellent lectures and insightful presentations on the theme during these two days. There were 67 posters presented for the poster session on November 9, and 4 posters were chosen for the Excellent Poster Award.

Participants of the symposium at onsite counted 131, and 51 of them joined from 6 overseas countries while 22 joined online in two days. Participants have expressed that this international symposium holds significant academic value in the field, and we also believe this is an important academic conference contributing to the enhancement of our university's international standing.

The symposium was supported by UOEH's 40th anniversary project, Kitakyushu Convention and Visitors Association, Saneikai and UOEH Service ltd, and sponsored by Japan Human Factors and Ergonomics Society.
