<IIES renews its accreditation as a WHO Collaborating Centre>

On August 5, 2024, the accreditation of the Institute of Industrial Ecological Sciences (IIES) as a WHO Collaborating Centre (WHO-CC) for Occupational Health was renewed. With this renewal, IIES will continue its activities as a WHO-CC for four years from July 23, 2024 to July 23, 2028. *WHO: World Health Organization
Since 1988, IIES has been active as a WHO-CC in the field of Occupational Health, mainly in Asia. In recent years, Prof. Yasuo Morimoto (Dept. Occupational Pneumology) and Assoc. Prof. Tomohiro Ishimaru (Dept. of Medical Humanities) have provided lectures for workshops on occupational lung diseases in Vietnam, Mongolia, Cambodia and Lao-PDR, together with other WHO-CCs such as the Catholic University of Korea and Asbestos and Dust Diseases Research Institute in Australia, with which UOEH has concluded an MOU, as well as National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health, Japan (JNIOSH).
