From September 5 to December 19, this year's teleconference seminar on International Environmental and Occupational Health Program was held online with 3 other overseas universities: National Taiwan University (main site), Universiti Brunei Darussalam, Khon Kaen University (Thailand) and Singapore National University.

This year, UOEH participated in 15 sessions including 12 lectures primarily on occupational and environmental health from international perspectives provided by lecturers of 4 participating universities.
