From September 16 to 17, we welcomed a total of 18 visitors from University of Putra Malaysia, including 14 undergraduate students majoring in Environmental and Occupational Health and 4 faculty members. Under the leadership of Prof. Yoko Kawamura (Dept. of Occupational Safety and Health Management), we conducted an exchange program with students from the School of Health Sciences, UOEH.

After presenting on the occupational health environments in their respective countries, the students worked in mixed groups to discuss and present commonalities between Malaysia and Japan, as well as areas where mutual learning could be beneficial.
