Under the Sakura Science Exchange Program supported by Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST), UOEH welcomed a delegation of five members from China Medical University in Taiwan, consisting of two graduate students, two undergraduate students, and one accompanying faculty member from November 6 to 19.

This program, planned and implemented under the leadership of Assoc. Prof. Tomohisa Nagata (Dept. of Occupational Health Practice and Management), focused on the theme of “Collaborative Research with China Medical University for the International Implementation of Occupational Health Research and Health and Productivity Management.” The program included lectures on health management and ergonomics, presentations and discussions by students and resident doctors at UOEH, as well as off-campus company visits.

During their stay, on November 14 and 15, the delegation participated in the UOEH International Symposium 2025. Prof. Ro-Ting Lin, the accompanying faculty member, delivered a lecture, while three graduate students presented their posters.
