

<2026 [4th News]> Annual exchange program with the Graduate School of Occupational Health, the Catholic University of Korea (Posted on March 16, 2026)

On Friday, January 30, 2026, a delegation of 27 faculty members and graduate students from the Graduate School of Occupational Health at the Catholic University of Korea visited UOEH for an annual exchange program. This annual exchange programs between the Institute of Industrial Ecological Sciences, UOEH and the Catholic University of Korea have been conducted every year except during the COVID-19 pandemic based on the academic exchange agreement (MOU) concluded in February 2003.

The group visited on-site clinic at Itozu no Mori Zoological Park, where the Department of Radiobiology and Hygiene Management of UOEH conducts field research on radiation exposure among veterinary medical staff, providing participants with practical insights into occupational health issues in veterinary practice. Following this, a research presentation session was held on UOEH campus, with the attendance of faculty members, residents, and graduate students from both institutions. The session featured lively discussions on the current situations in both countries and on each participant's research topics.
