

<2026 [14th News]> The 13th UI-NRH-UOEH Joint Interesting Occupational Medicine Regular Forum was held (Posted on May 29, 2026)

On Thursday, May 21, the 13th UI-NRH-UOEH Joint Interesting Occupational Medicine Regular Forum was held online, jointly organized by three institutions, University of Indonesia (UI), Nopparat Rajathanee Hospital (NRH), Thailand and UOEH.

The forum aims to promote mutual understanding of legal systems and medical practices on occupational health among the participating countries. Since September 2022, it has been held once every three months. In each forum, residents of occupational medicine of the host country deliver presentations, and online participants join discussions afterwards.

This time, the forum was organized and hosted by UI and their two residents in Occupational Medicine presented on the topics of “Small Cell Lung Carcinoma in a Dip-Soldering Worker: Assessing Occupational Exposure” and “Malignant Melanoma in a Vegetable Farmer”. Approximately 100 participants attended the forum, and an active discussion followed the presentations.
